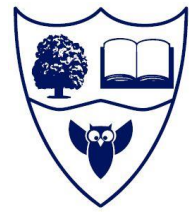


Class assembly - Parents/ carers of children in Y5 are warmly invited to their class assembly on Thursday 17th November at 9.15am.

This is an opportunity for you to meet with your child's teacher, discuss your child's progress and look at their books. When you go to the log in screen you will need to complete some basic information about you and your child. If you have any problems with your booking, please call the school office and we will be able to help.

Parents of children with SEN support plans should already have had their parents meeting within the last few weeks, so there is no need to sign up for another appointment.

School meals –TLC, our school meals provider, has increased their charges to school for lunches, which means that we are left with no other option but to increase the cost to parents. Therefore, from Monday 14th November school meals will be charged at £2.65 a day (Reception, Y1 and Y2 children continue to receive free school meals from the government).

Christmas Fair – believe it or not, it is only just over 3 weeks to our Christmas Fair! The Fair, is being held on Friday 25th November between 5pm and 8pm. In order to help to collect donations for our fair we will be having two more non-uniform days (we had our first on the day of the disco to collect chocolate donations).



Friday 11th November – children can wear non-uniform in exchange for any item for our toy tombola e.g. new toys, books, games etc.

Friday 25th November – children can wear non-uniform in exchange for any unopened bottle e.g. wine, bubble bath, sauce etc.



Children in Need – it is Children in Need this year on Friday 18th November. We are going to be having a pyjama day to raise money for Children in Need. If your child would like to wear their pyjamas to school for the day, please log into ParentPay and make a donation to Children in Need (suggested donation £1).
